Course Description

Dear 5th Grade Parent,

Your child is interested in becoming a member of the Mary Lillard Leopard Choir! I am looking forward to an exciting year of concerts, competitions and social events. Please review this course description with your student. If you are interested in enrolling your child in the Leopard Choir, return this signed paper to Mrs. Bonine on or after the due date.

Commitment: 6th Grade Leopard Choir is a year-long elective. Students will study rhythm and solfege daily to improve their music reading and writing skills. We will study traditional choral music, including music in many different languages. Choir students commit to working hard, being respectful of every team member and SINGING EVERY DAY!

Performances: There will be a minimum of three evening performances during the school year. Evening performances are **REQUIRED** and graded. They take place at Willie Pigg or the Performing Arts Center, depending on availability. Performances generate a majority of the test grades in this class.

Your student will receive an updated hardcopy of the handbook for 2017-2018 during the first week of school next year.

Required Supplies:

Uniform Shirt for performances: \$15.00 (not due at this time)
1 inch binder, any pattern or color
1 pack of dividers (8 count)
Pencil pouch, with two sharpened pencils
1 pack of notebook paper

“No Pass/No Play”: According to Texas state law, students must be passing all classes with a 70% or higher to participate in some events. Leopard Choir students participate in the Pride of Texas Music Festival in the spring semester. This is a competition festival and “No Pass/No Play” applies.

Fundraiser: During the year, we will have some required after school practices and social events. There will be a Choir fundraiser in late October to generate money to pay for these events.
